



## Aurealis Awards 2010 Entry Form

The Aurealis Awards 2010 are for works of speculative fiction by authors, editors and illustrators, who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, first published in English between **1 November 2009** and **31 December 2010**.

Works may be entered in more than one category, but we encourage you to only choose the most relevant, rather than make across-the-board, blanket entries.

There is no fee to enter works for the awards, and anyone may enter a work into the Aurealis Awards process. But in entering a work, you undertake to supply one copy of the work to each of the judges of the relevant category/categories – i.e., you'll need to supply a minimum of three copies of the work entered.

Finalists will be announced on the website in late March 2010, and the winners announced at the Aurealis Awards ceremony to be held in Sydney in April/ May 2011.
